

### Fractions

You can create a fraction in LaTeX using the command `\frac{numerator}{denominator}`.

$$\frac{1}{2}$$

`\frac{1}{2}`

$$m = \frac{\Delta y}{\Delta x}$$

`m=\frac{\Delta y}{\Delta x}`

$$\frac{1}{1 - \frac{1}{x}}$$

`\frac{1}{1-\frac{1}{x}}`

$$\frac{d}{dx} \sin(x) = \cos(x)$$

`\frac{d}{dx}\sin(x)=\cos(x)`

### Roots

You can create a square root in LaTeX using the command `\sqrt{expression}`.

$$\sqrt{100} = 10$$

`\sqrt{100}=10`

$$\sqrt{b^2}$$

`\sqrt{b^2}`

You can create an n<sup>th</sup> root in LaTeX using the command `\sqrt[n]{expression}`.

$$\sqrt[3]{27} = 3$$

`\sqrt[3]{27}=3`

$$\sqrt[n]{x - \sqrt{x^2 - x}}$$

`\sqrt[n]{x-\sqrt{x^2-x}}`
